



The Patterns

Sizing Guidelines

Child Small	Age 3-5
Child Medium	Age 6-11
Child Large / Adult Sm	Age 12 / petite adult
Adult Regular	Fits most adults

If possible, it's helpful to trace the hand you're fitting mittens for, minus the thumb. Then compare to the various sizes to see which is the best fit. Take into account the seam allowances when choosing the appropriate size.

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$." That said, there's plenty of leeway to adjust to $\frac{1}{2}$ " seams to create a slightly smaller mitten. These are your patterns now; own them!

When printing, be sure to print at 100%. Deselect "shrink to fit" or anything that would prevent proper scaling. The margins of the Mitten Top, in particular, exceed the allowances, prompting a shrinking prior to printing.

*note about the Adult Regular pattern: depending on your printer's margins, part of the top and/or bottom of the pattern may be cut off. I could think of no way around this. Go ahead and extrapolate and round off the pattern to match the rounded portion of the corresponding size's Back - Top piece. This piece should measure $10 \frac{5}{8}$ " from top to bottom.
